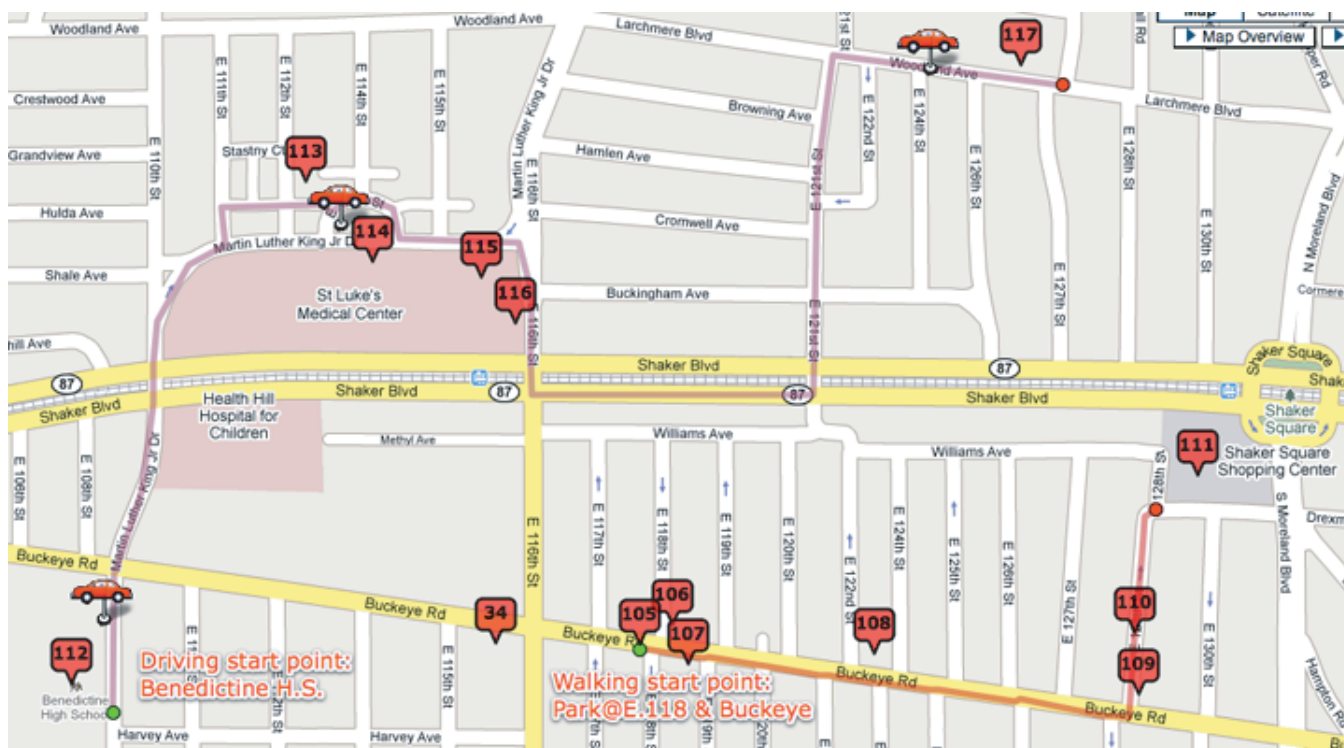




Buckeye Neighborhood: Arts & Culture Promenade
